

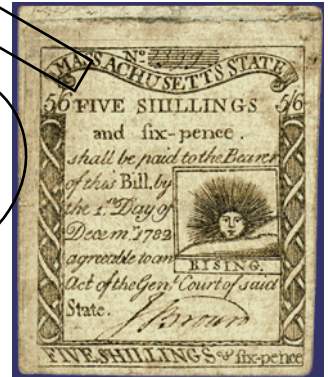
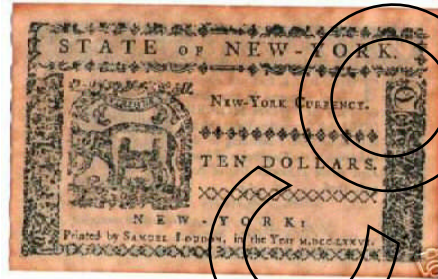
## CREATING A REPUBLIC (1776 - 1790) – LESSON 2

**Objective: To examine the weaknesses of the Articles of Confederation.**

**Why did the Articles of Confederation fail?**

### I. Currency Issues

- The United States **did not have** a \_\_\_\_\_.

### II. Debt

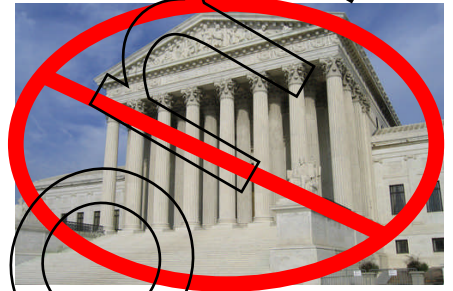
